Upon completion of an enrollment application potential students are interviewed and apprised of the following.

COMPENSATION: According to a 2013 report the National Accrediting Commission of Career Arts and Sciences the average salary for licensed professionals is \$18.50 per hour, which is above the national average.

EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITIES: We maintain a placement service, which is available to graduating students and past students. Area salon managers contact the school and leave information about job opportunities currently available. A placement service information form is filled out and placed on the student "Job Bulletin Board". We also arrange for salon owners and managers to speak to the senior students when they are looking for new employees. Job advising is available with the administrator upon request. (Job placement is not guaranteed.)

PHYSICAL DEMANDS OF THE PROFESSION: Cosmetology requires standing on your feet for long periods of time. Bending from the waist when shampooing and working on clients when reclined in the shampoo bowl. Contact with chemicals may lead to allergic reaction that may cause skin irritation. Hot irons, sharp cutting tools and electrical apparatus are being used. Manicuring requires long sitting times: close work and excellent eyesight and good hand and eye coordination. Estheticians require sitting, standing, bending from the waist, and good hand and eye coordination, contact with chemicals that may cause reaction.

SAFTY REQUIREMENTS: All seniors are licensed by the State Board of Cosmetology, which has inspectors, who inspect salons for sanitation and cleanliness. You should always read the directions on all products packages.

LICENSING REQUIREMENTS: 1800 Hour Managing Cosmetology- 300 Hour Managing Manicuring_750 Hour Managing Esthetics-1050 Hour Combination Esthetics/Manicuring to obtain a license for any of the above, written and practical examinations must be taken which is given at the State Board of Cosmetology in Grove City, Ohio. All tests take no longer than one day.

COMPLETION RATES-LICENSURE RATES- AND PLACEMENT RATES:

64.71% of the students in the programs scheduled to complete in 2013 went on to graduate.

96.67% of the students in the program passed the State Board Examination in 2013

78.79% of the students who graduated in 2013 have found jobs as licensed professionals in the beauty industry.

REQUIREMENTS TO BEGIN CLASS: Written Application, Personal Interview, High School Diploma or GED, Driver License, State I.D. Social Security Card, a completed and signed Enrollment Agreement (Contract).
